CERAWeek by S&P Global convened more than 10,000 participants from around the world to explore the strategies for an energy world undergoing rapid transformation, addressing our 2024 theme "Multidimensional Energy Transition: Markets, climate, technology and geopolitics."

Further complicating the picture are issues ranging from rising geopolitical and economic uncertainties to new supply chains for net zero, energy market volatility, accelerating technological change and AI, the "capital transition," increasing demand for hydrocarbons and electric power, and the intensifying climate and sustainability agenda. All these raise critical questions about whether the energy transition will be orderly and balanced or disruptive and chaotic? Energy security is once again an urgent consideration. How will strategies, policies, investments and the competitive landscape be reshaped? What new collaborations and business models will emerge? How will industry, government and civil society respond? Will innovation deliver and scale, and at what pace?

CERAWeek added two formats to participate in strategic thinking and knowledge sharing with the introduction of Strategic Roundtable plenaries and the Expert Zone for interactive dialogues with S&P Global experts. CERAWeek also provides Professional Development Programs and Women in Energy Special Programs.

The Innovation Agora by CERAWeek explores innovation and technology solutions in a variety of formats. These include Studios and Voices of Innovation offering close-up dialogue with thought leaders on a broad range of topics. Meanwhile our topical Hydrogen, Carbon and Climate Hubs provide dedicated forums for leadership dialogues.
